Photo 13: Two sizes of waste bowls and large round open serving bowl

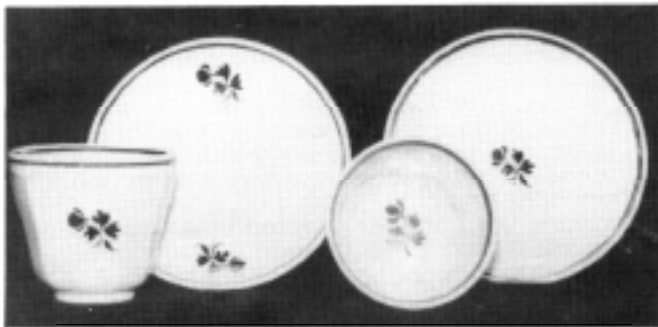


Photo 14: Two styles of handleless cups and saucers

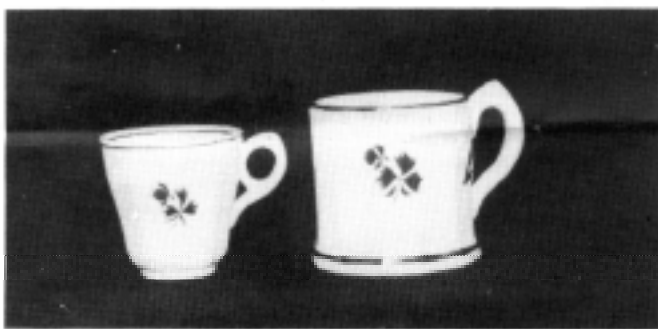


Photo 15: Rare tea or posset cup and mug

Photo 9: A rarely-seen sight! Complete (4-piece) soup and sauce tureens. (Only two such soup tureens are currently known-one complete and one partial.)

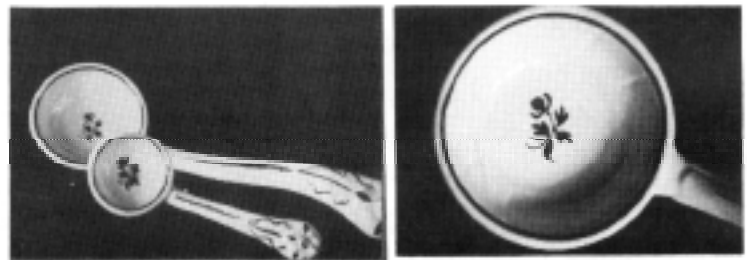


Photo 10: Close-UP of Chinese ladles-notice that even the bowl of the ladle is paneled.
