■ Circa: 1860's; reproduced 1950-1960's

| Potter(s): W. Adams

■ Characteristics: Hexagonal spheroid body, mushroom knob finial, domed lid, modified bracket handles, six widely flared panels indenting to the foot, ribbing on lid and near foot

Cable (Ring 'n Cable)

| Circa: 1870's and 1880's

| Potter(s): Shaw, Burgess, Furnival, Challinor, Meakin and others

| Characteristics: Ring and cable arch finial, domed lid, cylindrical pear shape, shaped base, flared rim, ring and cable embossing at handle terminals, C-Shaped handles

Hill Shape (Medallion Scroll)

■ Circa: 1860's

■ Potter(s): Clementson Bros.

■ Characteristics: Cylindrical pear shape body, C-shape handle on coffeepot, shaped base, embossed vertical panels at neck and embossed medallions on lower body

Bamboo

■ Circa: Registered 1873

■ Potter(s): Alfred Meakin, W.H. Grindley

| Characteristics: Square body with slightly rounded sides, plateau lid with rounded sides, bamboo horizontal arch finial, bracket handles, bamboo embossing

| Circa: Registered 1884

| Potter(s): John Edwards

| Characteristics: Horizontal dolphin arch finial, high plateau lid, shaped base with bracket feet, modified bracket handles, dolphin heads on finial and handles

| Potter(s): Many English and American potters

| Characteristics: Characterized by generally simple square shapes
