

Climbing the Tea Leaf Family Tree: Copper-Lustre Decorated Ironstone 1840-1860 (Continued)

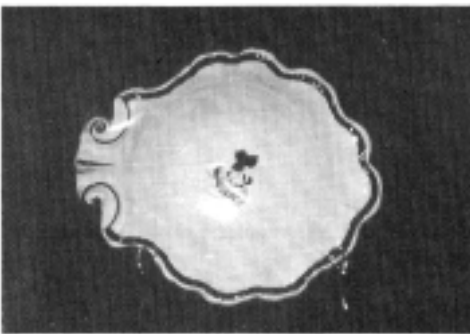
